The ideal candidate will possess knowledge, skills, and mental development equivalent to completion of four years of high school; successfully complete 8,000 hours of on-the-job training and related written instruction within four years of the Apprenticeship Program; obtain and maintain HAZMAT certification; have the ability to obtain and maintain First Aid and CPR certifications; meet all current requirements of the Labor Agreement between District 9, International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers (IAMAW) and the City of Springfield; hold a valid Class D Illinois driver's license; and acquire and maintain a Commercial Driver's License within the six-month probationary period. **Preference for employment in all positions with the city shall be given to applicants who are full-time city residents.**
