- Manage joint pole contracts with other utilities, facility transfers, and right-of-way research including easements and permits.
- Manage preparation of specifications, evaluation of construction materials, and administration of policies, rules, and specifications for electric service across all customer types.
- Oversee the Geographic Information System (GIS) for all Transmission and Distribution assets and electrical system connectivity.
- Prepare and administer the budget for the Transmission and Distribution Engineering Department, covering all projects, services, and departmental operations.

The ideal internal candidate will possess knowledge, skill, and mental development equivalent to a Bachelor of Science degree in Electrical Engineering from an accredited college or university, along with at least five years of experience in electric transmission and distribution systems, including three years in a supervisory role, or any equivalent combination of education and experience. Registration as a Professional Engineer in the State of Illinois is desirable, and the candidate must hold a valid Class D driver's license. **Preference for employment in all positions with the city shall be given to applicants who are full-time city residents.**
