In this role you will:

- Successfully retain and apply all aspects of the Operator Training Program from Operator Trainee I through full qualification as an Electric System Operator responsible for CWLP's portion of the Bulk Electric System.
- Perform reliably under high-pressure and stressful operating conditions, demonstrate strong focus, self-discipline, and the ability to study and apply complex technical material.
- Meet all certification and operational requirements, including passing the Basic Fundamentals of System Switching exam within 3 months and the NERC System Operator exam within 6 months, while supporting rotating shift work and cross-training for Trouble Clerk and Service Clerk duties and advancement to Operator Trainee II.
- Participate in structured on-the-job training with provided study materials while maintaining the ability to recall and execute previously learned operational functions.

Qualifications:

Candidates who wish to apply will be **required** to take the JATC test at **their own expense**. Candidates who successfully pass the exam will advance to the next phase of the selection process, which includes an in-person interview. Following the interview, candidates will complete a cognitive assessment, and those who successfully pass will be invited to participate in a second interview.
